DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is a concentrate and must be diluted before using. See table below.

Before applying **KleenGrow**, first dislodge heavy soil buildup using **STRIP-IT** or **HORTI-KLOR** and a high-pressure washer.

KleenGrow is biodegradable and safe to use on stainless steel, aluminum, iron, concrete, plastic, poly and glass. Avoid contact with growing plants at more than 0.38 fl.oz. per gallon.

Application Methods

KleenGrow may be applied using high or low pressure spray equipment, or by brush.

PACE ACBD System

ACBD stands for *Always Clean Before Disinfecting* and represents a system which will enable you to comply with all **Food Safety** and **HACCP** requirements.

KleenGrow is one part of the system. Contact your representative for advice on how to implement the full **PACE ACBD System**.

Greenhouse Wash

Horticultural and Agricultural Applications:

KleenGrow may be used in **Greenhouses, Nurseries, Interiorscapes, Botanical Gardens, Atriums, Packing Houses, Commercial/Retail Florists, Bouquet Manufacturers** and by **Vegetable Growers**.

Areas of use include storage sheds, packing lines, coolers, trucks, pots, plug trays, bins, ground cover, shade cloth, growing benches, troughs, irrigation lines, transportation, trucking, disposal areas, lunchrooms, washrooms, beds, structures, packing sheds, picking equipment, food-handling equipment, totes, and equipment including tools and cutters.

Livestock Applications:

KleenGrow has many applications on **Poultry, Pig, Cattle** and **Dairy Farms**.

Areas of use include animal pens, barns, parlors, drinkers, cages, receiving areas, egg rooms, kill floors, storage areas, packing equipment, processing areas and for general cleaning.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

FIRST AID

Flammable. Skin and Eye Irritant

Keep away from sources of ignition. No smoking. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear suitable gloves. Wear eye protection.
